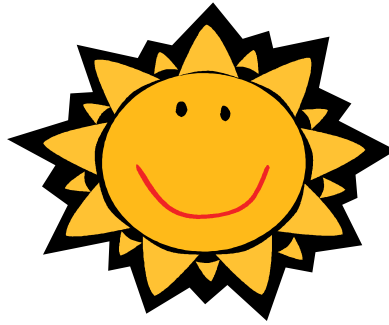




Killamarsh Infant and Nursery School
