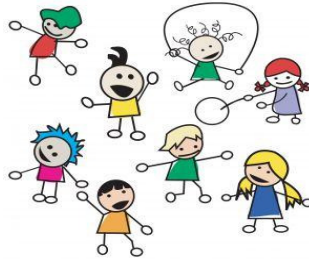




# Killamarsh Infant and Nursery School

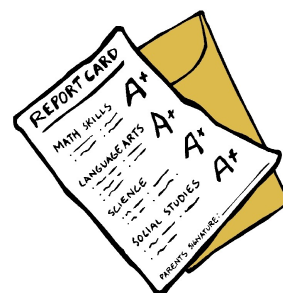
