Primary PE and School Sport

In April 2013, the Government announced new funding of £150 million for physical education (PE) and sport. This funding should be used to improve the quality and breadth of PE and sport provision. Funding is allocated to all maintained and state funded schools with primary phase pupils.

Schools are free to determine how best to use this funding to improve the quality and breadth of PE and sport provision, including increasing participation in PE and sport so that all pupils develop healthy lifestyles and reach the performance levels they are capable of.

How will we be spending the PE and Sport funding and who will benefit?

Killamarsh Infant and Nursery School have selected to use the funding of **£13,344** in 2017 /18 in the following ways:

- pooling some of the additional funding with that of other local schools in the North East Derbyshire School Sport Partnership
- attending sport competitions and festivals
- developing the school facilities
- paying for professional development opportunities for teachers in PE and sport
- providing cover to release primary teachers for professional development in PE and sport
- developing quality assured professional development modules or materials for PE and sport

We are investing £1,600 of our funding in affiliating to the North East Derbyshire School Sports Partnership (NED SSP). NED SSP is passionate about improving the lives of young people, by providing opportunities through Physical education and Sport. NED SSP will provide a core package to support the school in:

Physical Education

- Continuous professional development signposting and support
- Inclusion training and support
- PE and School Sport Audit

Competition

- Level 1 School Games (intra-school) support
- Access to Level 2 School Games calendar appropriate for age-group (inter-school/cluster/district)

Leadership and Volunteering

- Mini-Leader programme - training / mentoring
- School Sport Organising Crew development (primary)

Club and Community Links

- Signposting to local clubs through competition programmes
