## Behaviour systems in place and working well.

You may have noticed on the website that we have put a diagram of how our behaviour policy works in school. The full policy will be in place as soon as possible.

The children understand the system and how it works within the class, trying to celebrate good behaviour all the time. The children have a card and if they have been good all week they will receive a stamp from their teacher.

Children receiving a red card will miss some of their golden time or if in Reception some explore time.

Sometimes a child's behaviour necessitates time out of class in a partner class where work is taken and time given for cooling down. If this happens you will be sent a letter to come and meet with the class teacher.

If the incident is severe the child will be sent to the Head teacher and spend time there. A letter will be sent for you to come and meet with the Head.

The emphasis is on the children being good in class and rewarding consistent good behaviour. Please look on the website and also talk to your child about the system. Our behaviour coordinator in school is Mrs. Atkin.
