

Pupil Premium Provision Statement/Report July 2017 – Pat Stockdale

Statement from the Inspection Dashboard :

Strengths in 2016

- KS1 disadvantaged pupil, attainment of greater depth in all subjects for all EYFS development groups was close to (within one pupil below national) or above national figures for other pupils.

Weaknesses in 2016

- Fewer than 70% of all pupils and disadvantaged pupils met the expected standard in phonics in Y1.
- Fewer than 80% of all pupils and disadvantaged pupils met the expected standard in phonics in Y2.
- Attendance was low for the groups: FSM, boys, SEN, SEN support.
- Persistence absence was high for all pupils and the groups: FSM, boys, SEN support.

Attendance

Y1 PP Pupils (6):

100% achieved above 94%

Y2 PP Pupils (12):

83% achieved above 94%

Two pupils have been tracked by the MAT team since March 2017.

One's attendance remains variable around 80% and the second (SEN) is improving and is now 93%.

FS2 PP Pupils (5):

60% achieved above 94%

Since March 2017, four pupils have been monitored by the MAT team.

One requires no further action. Two are improving and are continuing to be monitored. One remains consistently low and will go to panel.
