A Day in FS2...

8.50am

The children have register in our register room before transferring upstairs to begin focussed teaching time.

9.00am

We introduce the day by singing the Days of the Week song, writing the date and looking at the timetable so that all the children are aware of what will happen during the day. This is also a chance for children to share their thoughts and important news.

9.10am

We begin a whole class introduction to the focus lesson which might be Literacy or Maths. This could be a story, practical demonstration, a game or some word or number work.

9.20am

Children then explore inside the classroom or outside in our Foundation Stage 2 area whilst others work with an adult on the focus task. All children will work with the adult during the morning and have time to explore.





11.00am

All children do a daily phonics session: the children learn their letters and how to read and write words and simple sentences.

11.30am

We do our Wake and Shake; a fun and important time for active movement to music. Then its lunchtime!

1.00pm

After register we sometimes go to assembly with our KS1 friends. Then we do our reading or a focussed topic session where we might talk about the world or learn new creative skills.

2.30pm

We have a quiet time where we enjoy stories, learning RE or join in with Circle Time activities, before we get our things for home time.

Some days are a little different, such as Fridays, where we do PE or go outside with our wellies on but every day we have some focussed work time as well as free play opportunities.
