Our theme this half term was  
'Old MacDonald had a Farm'.

Your challenge is to write your name in the middle of a piece of paper. Then you need to draw your favourite farm animals around your name and colour them in. Tell your grown up what noise each animal makes and what sound the animal name starts with. If you're up for a bit of a bigger challenge you can work with your grown up to spell the animal name by using your robot arms to segment the word e.g. p-i-g, d-u-ck, sh-ee-p. When you have finished your pictures and writing you can play 'I spy a farm animal' with your grown up to practise your initial sounds!
